Setting Up the Speaker Stand

Loosen the bottom tripod adjustment knob (counter clockwise).



Turn the stand upside down and separate the legs.



Turn the stand right side up and while holding above ground, push the collar down until the legs are extended and leg braces are parallel to the ground.



Adjust the inner tube to the desired height (best performance with speaker above crowd level).

Tighten the tripod height adjustment knob (clockwise).

Tighten the bottom tripod adjustment knob (clockwise).

Setting Up the Liberty Unit



Line up the speaker stand port with the bottom of the Liberty's base Place the Liberty on the speaker stand.



Managing the Optional Built-in CD Unit

CD player is automatically active when you turn on the power When CD is inserted, indicator light illuminates.

Push PLAY to begin playback Insert disk into CD player





Volume control can be adjusted using the CD VOLUME knob on the back panel.

Track skip features can be utilized by pressing either the UP or DOWN buttons. Press and hold either UP or DOWN buttons to fast forward or rewind.

Wireless Functions

A wireless microphone is included and batteries are installed. To operate, turn the POWER switch ON.

Frequency selection

Open the battery compartment of the microphone. Using the enclosed screwdriver, select the same channel on the wireless microphone.

ATTENTION: If interference occurs, select a different channel.

Use the WIRELESS MIC VOLUME to control the sound level

Speech Projection should be in the "on" position for large crowds. Speech Projection should be in the "off" position for full range music.

Troubleshooting Wireless mic performance"Drop Out" in audio

 Verify that mic battery is good (indicator should be solid).

Helpful tips


- Do not operate mic closer than 15 ft. or directly in front of Xtreme.
- 2. Reduce input volume and speak louder.
- 3. Hold mic close to your mouth.



Adding an unpowered companion speaker to the Liberty

The first Liberty (6000) can power a second Liberty (6001):

- -A speaker cable is included
- Plug one end into the SPEAKER OUT of the LIB-6000HCU1
- Plug one end into the SPEAKER INPUT jack of the LIB-6001




Safety strap and cord wrap
